










## **BAYSHORE BIKEWAY PLAN**








#### **NORTH OF 28TH STREET**


Existing perpendicular parking on north side of Harbor.

STA 94+00 OPTION B - Planted median with no on-street parking on north side













#### ACCOMMODATING OVERSIZE CARGO AT CESAR CHAVEZ PARKWAY



There is no raised median on Harbor Blvd at Cesar Chavez in order to accommodate the movement of oversize cargo out of the Port.








#### HARBOR AT PARK BOULEVARD
