



SuperLoop Joins Rapid network on Sunday, September 6, 2015

SuperLoop Rapid 201 and **202** will provide weekday riders with more service and more capacity with:

- **Environmentally friendly vehicles** powered by clean natural gas (CNG).
- **Higher capacity** articulated vehicles with seating for 52 passengers plus additional standing room, improved lighting, more headroom and bigger windows.
- **10-minute peak service** extended to the majority of the day.

SuperLoop Rapid 204 will use hybrid *Rapid* vehicles and provide 15-minute service.

Connections to *SuperLoop Rapid 204* from *Rapid 201* and *202* will be at the UTC Transit Center.

And *SuperLoop Rapid* routes connect you to other MTS routes like *Rapid 237* to Mira Mesa and Rancho Bernardo and Route 150 at either the Gilman or UTC Transit Centers.

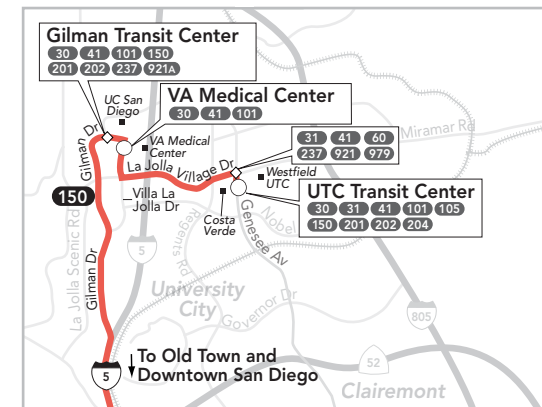
