The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) will host the last of three community workshops on the **Rose Creek Bikeway Project** at the Mission Bay High School Library. Come to the open house-style meeting to see the preferred design for this important regional bikeway connection. Based on input received from the community and public participation at previous workshops, the Rose Creek Bikeway is

proposed as a combination of a bike path, separate from motor vehicle traffic, and an on-street, two-way cycle track. The project will connect existing sections of the Rose Canyon and Rose Creek bike paths in the City of San Diego, filling an approximately two-mile gap in the regional bicycle network. The goal is to provide a comfortable bike-riding environment for people of all ages and abilities.
