SR 76 Middle Project Construction Advisory #10

All Lanes Along SR 76 Middle Segment are Now Open

Commuters are getting a wonderful gift just in time for the holidays. Tomorrow, November 20, the final eastbound lane between Melrose Drive and South Mission Road will open to traffic.

As part of the Middle Segment Project, the original 2-lane highway was reconstructed into four lanes. All four lanes are now open and in their final configuration.

The improvements to the SR 76 are part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and the voter approved half-cent sales tax program, TransNet, which funds the region's transportation projects. The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) administers TransNet and works in partnership with Caltrans to build the SR 76 Middle Segment. This new four-lane highway will be a key transportation asset to help meet future travel demand.
