Trolley Station Construction & Detours



Fifth Avenue Trolley Station

Mid-December 2012 – Early April 2013

The **Fifth Avenue Trolley Station** is anticipated to be **CLOSED FOR RENOVATION** beginning mid-December 2012 through early April 2013. Trolley access will be available at the City College and Civic Center Stations during the closure. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the Trolley system.

Station/Rider Information

- The Fifth Avenue Station will be closed for construction beginning mid-December 2012 through early April 2013. Improvements include new station boarding platforms, next-arrival electronic signs, shelters, and more.
- During construction, riders will be able to access the trolley from the City College or Civic Center Stations. Signage at the stations will be in place to alert patrons of the closure.
- The bus stop at 5th Avenue & C Street will remain open during construction, although it may close temporarily due to an unrelated construction project. If a temporary closure is required, a notice will be placed at the bus stop.



New low-floor cars are now operating on the Orange Line through downtown.

Street/Business Information

- Most work will occur between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Noise and dust is anticipated during construction. Limited night work is anticipated.
- During construction, there may be temporary lane closures on Fifth and Sixth Avenues to allow for construction deliveries or construction activities.
- Access for pedestrians and local businesses around the station will be maintained during construction.

The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
