Construction at Blue Line Trolley Track Crossings

October 2012

Construction, including electrical and signaling maintenance, will occur all weekend at the trolley crossings listed below beginning at **8 p.m. on Friday, October 12, to 4 a.m. on Monday, October 15, and from 8 p.m. on Friday, October 19, to 4 a.m. on Monday, October 22.** Minimal noise and dust is anticipated during construction and there may be some minor traffic impacts due to test trains that will be operating. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the trolley system.

Trolley Crossings under Electrical and Signaling Maintenance on October 12-15 and October 19-22:

- Sigsbee Street, between Harbor Drive and Main Street
- Beardsley Street, between Harbor Drive and Main Street
- Cesar E. Chavez Parkway, between Harbor Drive and Main Street
- Sampson Street, between Harbor Drive and Main Street
- Schley Street, between Harbor Drive and Main Street
- 28th and Commercial intersection in San Diego
- 32nd and Commercial intersection in San Diego

In addition, construction to remove and replace the trolley tracks located between Sigsbee and Beardsley Streets in San Diego will occur all weekend beginning at **8 p.m. on Friday, October 26, to 4 a.m. on Monday, October 29.** This construction will involve the use of heavy equipment that will generate intermittent noise and traffic impacts. Traffic control measures will be in place at both trolley crossings.



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when traveling near the work area.

The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
