

NOTICE: NIGHTTIME CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Nighttime Trolley Construction Near Broadway and Kettner Boulevard

On Friday, August 3, nighttime work will continue on the Metropolitan Transit System Trolley's Overhead Contact System (OCS) near the intersection of Broadway and Kettner Boulevard. This work will include replacement of contact system components and adjustment of the electrical lines that power the Trolley.

Schedule

Work will occur from Friday, August 3, at 11: 30 p.m., to Saturday, August 4, at 4 a.m.

What You Can Expect During Construction

- Work will occur mostly on the tracks, but a closure of eastbound Broadway, from Kettner Boulevard to Pacific Highway will be necessary to allow crews to place equipment and complete their work safely.
- You may notice the presence of crews, work lights, and vehicle safety back-up alarms during construction. Crews will minimize impacts to the maximum extent possible.

Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

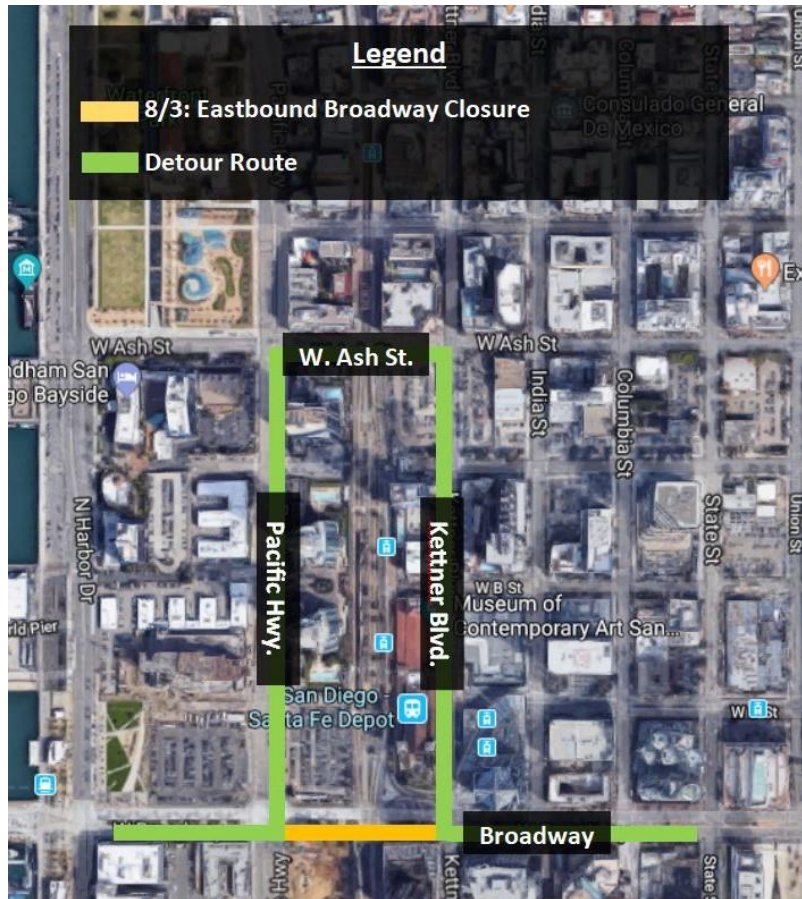
About the Project
