Station Construction: City College Trolley Station

The City College Trolley Station will be **TEMPORARILY** relocated to C Street between 10th and 11th Avenues from early September to mid-December for renovation work.

Schedule

- Late August 2012 Interim Trolley Station construction begins.
- Early September 2012 City College Trolley Station construction begins.
- Mid-December 2012 Construction completed.

Benefits

- New station platforms will allow low-floor trolleys to operate on the Orange Line in early 2013.
- Low-floor trolleys provide easier access for all passengers.
- New concrete paving will be installed on the station platform.

Station/Rider/Business Information

- One lane on 10th Avenue will be temporarily closed to accomodate this work.
- Access to businesses will be maintained. Please follow detour signs as necessary.
- Most work will occur between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Limited night work may occur.
- The schedule may change with very little notice.
- Noise and dust is anticipated during construction.
- Businesses at City College Trolley Station will be open during construction.

The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. Beginning in September, the Green Line will be extended through Old Town to downtown and terminate at 12th & Imperial via bayside stations (Seaport Village, Convention Center and Gaslamp Quarter). Also beginning in September, the Orange Line will travel from El Cajon to Santa Fe Depot and the Blue Line will travel from San Ysidro to America Plaza. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
