Trolley Station Closures & Detours



Spring Street Station in La Mesa

Late August – December 2012

Renovation work on the **Spring Street Trolley Station** started in late August and will continue through December 2012. The station **WILL REMAIN OPEN DURING CONSTRUCTION**, however construction detours are planned for passengers to follow when accessing the trolley. Please use extra caution during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

Station/Rider/Business Information

- Improvements for this project include new station boarding platforms to accommodate the low-floor trolleys, next-arrival electronic signs, shelters, track, switches and more.
- Once complete, passengers will experience a safer and more efficient boarding experience.
- Local businesses and pedestrian walkways outside of the station will remain accessible.
- Most work will occur between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- Limited night and weekend work may occur.
- Noise and dust is anticipated during construction.
- Construction will continue through December.



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Program is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
